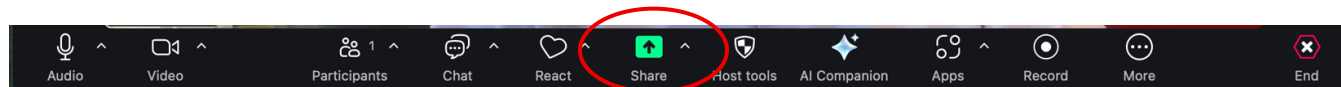

Enabling Sound in Zoom Screen Sharing

One unusual aspect when sharing presentations online is the inclusion of audio in addition to the graphics and text.

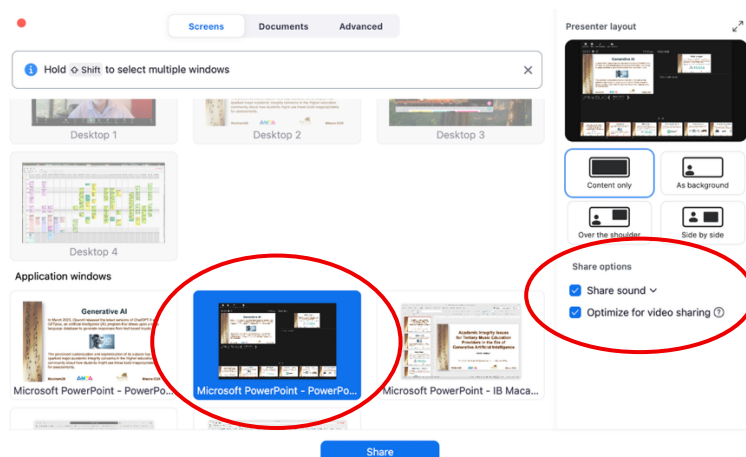
When you are ready to present, click on the 'Share' icon.



A window will then open allowing you to select what item you wish to share. There are 2 options here: 1) Choose a screen or 2) Choose an application. I advise using the *application windows* option as it limits what the meeting can see, rather than all of your personal files etc on your desktop – in this case I have selected a PowerPoint presentation.

There are 2 other steps required to include the audio with your presentation. Click on the check boxes for 1) "Share Sound" and 2) "Optimize for Video Sharing"

Next click 'Share'



You can now start your presentation as per the usual means.
