If humans stop growing while machines keep evolving, the future will not belong to intelligence. It will belong to dependency.

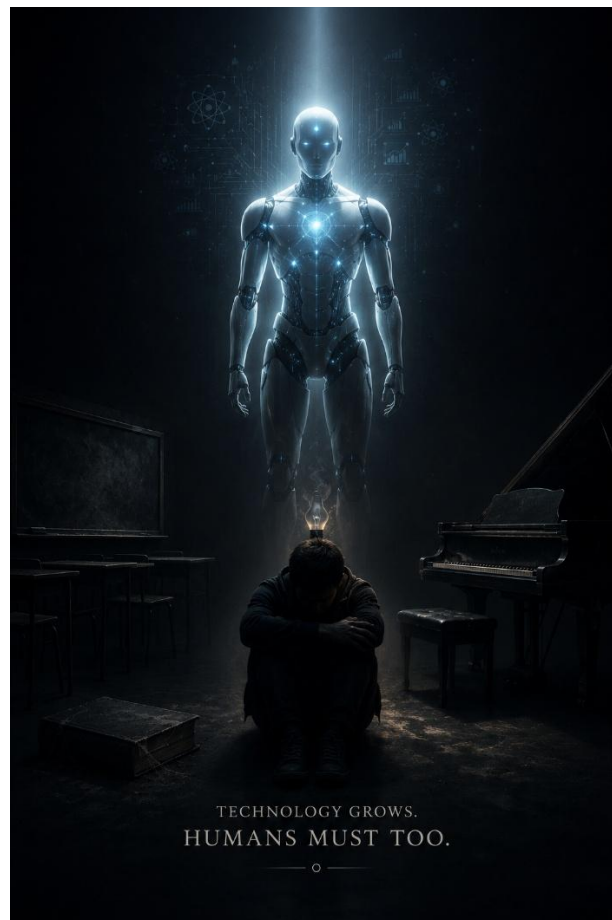
## The Terrifying Truth
